

Faculty Use of Drexel Libraries Services

Drexel University has agreed to participate in a federal study of the use, outcomes, and return-on-investment (ROI) of academic libraries conducted by the University of Tennessee Center for Information and Communication Studies. This study involves two parts: an in-depth cost study of services provided by the Drexel Libraries (which is completed) and surveys of faculty and students. Below is the faculty survey for you to complete. The survey asks you to answer questions about how often you use services and focuses on the most recent use, how much of your time is involved (this is an indicator of the value you place on the services), the purposes for using the services, and outcomes.

This survey will take up to 15 minutes to complete depending on the extent of your library use. The survey has been conducted on the ROI of library collections in the U.S. and several other countries and has been extremely useful to the libraries for decision-making and planning purposes.

You may exit the survey or leave a question unanswered at any time. There is minimal risk attached to your participation and any details about you and your work situation will be kept completely confidential. Any papers or conference presentations based on the collected data will contain only summary data without direct links to an individual survey response.
